



'Camping' is when people sleep outdoors in a tent instead of a bed.




We like to backpack and discover the nature all around us.

We like to prepare soups and pastas, which would give us the energy to go on a big hike.




At night, we like to grill *angelitos*, a type of small fish, and tell stories under the stars.



The following morning, we wake up early and put on our boots.






We walk through the mountains and watch the animals until we get tired.
